

Construction of Phase 2 – Biosolids Dewatering project at the Galesburg Sanitary District Wastewater Treatment Plant (WWTP) were financed by the Clean Water State Revolving Loan Fund (SRF). The SRF program is administered by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency and receives a portion of its money to fund these types of projects from the U. S. Environmental Protection Agency. This project includes construction of a new Biosolids Dewatering Building housing two Biosolids Dewatering Screw Presses, a new Biosolids Storage Building, a new Biosolids Pumping Building and associated site improvements. Once complete, this project will improve water quality for area residents and businesses in Galesburg, Illinois by providing proper disinfection of effluent from the WWTP, as required by the Galesburg Sanitary District's NPDES Permit. SRF programs operate in each state to provide communities the resources necessary to build, maintain and improve the infrastructure that protects one of our most valuable resources: water.
